Very few schools have been recognised in this way, and we are proud to be helping our children to be 'future ready' be equipping them with the skills that they will need as they move into senior school and beyond. Over the last academic year, we have enjoyed sharing our knowledge and expertise with our colleagues in schools in the local area, as well as other schools in the Cognita group across the UK. Part of the global Cognita Schools Group, the St. Mary's team work with Cognita's Digital Learning Advisor, who often visits to see the teachers and children in action. He then shares his expertise with other schools in the group, to showcase how to use their laptops and iPads to effectively supplement traditional teaching techniques.

At St. Mary's, the children in Early Years use iPads to access a variety of apps including handwriting programmes that enable children to make faster and more individualised progress. In Years 3-6, each child is given their own laptop, ensuring that the pupils acquire advanced IT literacy, using packages such as Adobe to present their work in video or book formats.

An extra curricular club for those keen to learn about coding, provides another opportunity for children to extend their knowledge. The Year 6 digital leaders support their younger peers as they learn to code robots, sharing their skills and enjoying their role as mentors. Pupils compete in coding competitions, and the older children enjoy their role as mentor to the younger pupils.

Rob Harmer, Headteacher: "We know that using appropriate Educational Technology tools can significantly enhance our children's learning. Our children learn to use technology, rather than simply be consumers, stretching their skills and ensuring that they are future ready as they look to their senior schools and beyond."
